With considerable sadness and regret, St Michael's York Trust has decided that Spurriergate Trading Company must cease to trade.

This means that our restaurant and café service will no longer be available from Thursday 5 July 2018.

The company is now being liquidated.

The Trustees would like to thank all present and former staff, volunteers, customers and supporters for all they have done to make Spurriergate a success for so long.

We have served people loyally and consistently for nearly thirty years.

This development does not affect other services provided by the Trust and host organisations. They will continue as usual.

These activities include the counselling service, International Café, Global church, and meals provided on Sunday mornings and Tuesday evenings for homeless people.

Sadly, the well publicised economic difficulties in town centres, and spells of extreme weather in 2018, amongst other things, have reduced our level of custom significantly and made our service unsustainable.

The Directors and management have done everything possible to mitigate the situation and reduce our costs, but this has not been sufficiently successful.
